



THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD
LODGE MEETING

HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, LONDON ROAD CAMBERLEY

ON NOVEMBER 27th 1912.

PRESENT WERE: 9 Officers including W/M W/Bro. Gamble

12 Members

4 Visitors

The lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 6.40 p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the brethren present

The lodge was then advanced to the 2nd. degree and W/Bro. W. Vaughan I.P.M. assumed the gavel when Bro. J. Meiklejohn was called to the p. and after having given proof of progress in the science was then entrusted with the Pass G & P.W leading from the 2nd to the 3rd degree. The Brother then retired to be prepared for the ceremony and on being re-admitted after the lodge had been advanced to the 3rd. degree he was raised to the sublime degree of a M.M. The ceremony being ably rendered by W. Bro. Vaughan. I.P.M.

The W.M. then re-assumed the Gavel and the lodge was lowered to the 1st degree.

The lodge Balance sheet for the year 1911-12 was then discussed, after which the adoption of same was proposed by Bro. J. Pearson and seconded by Bro. R.A. Hill and carried unanimously.
