



THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD
LODGE MEETING

HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, LONDON ROAD CAMBERLEY

ON NOVEMBER 26TH 1913.

PRESENT WERE: 13 OFFICERS including W/M W/Bro. W.E. MATTHEWS

MEMBERS: 16

VISITORS: 9

The Lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 5.50 p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the Brethren present.

A ballot was then taken for Mr. Percy Walter White who had been regularly proposed and seconded as a fit and proper person to become a Freemason and at its conclusion the ballot was found to be unanimous in his favour.

Mr. Percy Walter White was then introduced to the Lodge as a candidate properly prepared to be made a Mason and was duly initiated into the Ancient Mysteries and Privileges of Freemasonry, the ceremony being performed by W. Bro. W.E. Matthews W.M.

The charge in this degree was ably rendered by Bro. W.N. Blackaby S.W.

The entered apprentice having retired, Bro. E.H. Foster and Bro. A.J. Smithers were called to the P. and after having given proof of their progress in the science, were entrusted with the P.G. and P.W. leading from the 1st to the 2nd degree. They then retired to be prepared for the ceremony.

The Lodge was now advanced to the 2nd degree, when Bros. Foster and Smithers were re-admitted and passed to the degree of F.C. The ceremony being ably performed by W. Bro. W.E. Matthews W.M.

The Lodge was then lowered to the 1st degree, when the E.A. was re-admitted.

Bros. T. Goddard and R. Mitchell were then called to the P. and presented with their G. Lodge Certificates.

The Secretary then presented the report of Reference & Audit committee on the accounts for the year and on the proposition of Bro. E.C. Webley, seconded by Bro. H. Pyle, the balance sheet was adopted unanimously.

The W.M. then called upon the Secretary to read Lodge Bye Laws.

The Secretary reported that the application form to the Board of Benevolence on behalf of Mrs. Blyth had been received and the Lodge decided that same be signed. This was then done.
