

This is an extract from the minutes of the Albert Edward Lodge meeting held at the Cambridge Hotel on April 28th 1909.

Present were: 13 Officers inc The WM. W. Bro. Burn  
8 Members and 1 Guest.

The Lodge was opened at 6.00 pm and the minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

A ballot was then taken for 3 candidates for Initiation which proved to be in favour of all.

2 of the candidates were then introduced into the Lodge and Initiated by the W. Master and the Charge was delivered by the S.W.

The Lodge was then advanced to the 2nd Degree and Bro Haffenden gave proof of progress in the Science and was then Raised to the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree of a very ably by the W.Master .

The Lodge was then resumed in the 1st degree and W. Bro. Twort was appointed 'pro-tem' as Charity Steward.

A letter was then read from a widow seeking financial assistance from the Benevolent Fund and it was voted that a donation of 2 Guineas be made.

Apologies for absence had been received from several brethren.

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or the Albert Edward Lodge in particular the Lodge was closed with solemn prayer at 8.20 pm.
