

THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD LODGE
MEETING HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING LONDON ROAD CAMBERLEY
ON WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 18th 1912

The Lodge was opened in due form, after solemn prayer, at 6.50p.m.

The W/M then called upon the secretary to read the dispensation authorizing the alteration of date of meeting. This having been done the minutes of the last regular lodge were then read and confirmed.

The secretary was then called upon by the W/M to read the Albert Edward Lodge By-laws

The Lodge then proceeded to elect a W/M for the ensuing year. A ballot was taken and its conclusion was found unanimous in favour of Bro. William E. Mathews S.W. who then thanked the Brethren for the confidence & honour thus conferred.

A ballot was next taken for a Treasurer for the ensuing year, at the conclusion of which it was found to be unanimous in favour of W. Bro. D.W. Twort P.M. P.P. J.G.D

The lodge next proceeded to elect a tiler for the ensuing year and on the proposition of W. Bro. W. Vaughan P.M. seconded by Bro. J.J. Appleton S.D. Bro. Charles Parrant was unanimously elected.

The following notices of motion was then put to the lodge :- " that a P.M. jewel be presented to W. Bro. A. Gamble W.M. to mark a most successful year of office " Proposed by W. Bro. W.J. Burn P.M. and seconded by W. Bro. R. Shepherd P.M. Carried unanimously.

" That a Director of Ceremonies Jewel the value of three guineas be presented to W. Bro. G. Baskett P.M. P.P.G.P. as a token of the lodge appreciation of his services. Proposed by W. Bro. W. Vaughan I.P.M. seconded by W. Bro. R. Shepherd P.M.

Apologies for non-attendance were read from :- W. Bros. Ellis & Basket, Bros. Blackaby, Lunn, Webley & several other Brethren.

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or this lodge in particular it was closed in perfect harmony at 7. 45 p.m.
