

THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD  
LODGE MEETING HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, LONDON ROAD  
.....  
CAMBERLEY ON WEDNESDAY FEB. 22nd. 1911.

Present were: 13 Officers including W/M W/Bro. W. Vaughan  
12 Members

The Lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 6.15p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the brethren present.

A ballot was next taken on behalf of Bro. Walter Edward Leggett who had been regularly proposed and seconded as a joining member of this Lodge. At the conclusion of the ballot it was found to be unanimous in his favour. The newly elected Brother was then introduced to the W/M to whom he, in open Lodge, declared his adhesion to the B of C and promised due obedience to the G.M. and the rules & regulations of G.L. ( Bro. Leggett having joined from the Irish Constitution )

W. Bro. R. Shepperd I.P.M. then assumed the gavel and Bros. R.A. Hill and F. Pearson were called to the Pedestal and after they had given proof of progress in the science were then entrusted with the PG & PW leading from the 1st to the 2nd degree. They then retired to be prepared for the ceremony.

The Lodge was then advanced to the 2nd degree and Bros. Hill & Pearson were re-admitted and passed to the Degree of F.C the ceremony being ably rendered by W. Bro. R. Shepperd IPM. The F.Cs then retired and W. Bro. G. Baskett PM PGS D of C then assumed the gavel and Bro. H. Pyle was then called to the pedestal and after giving proof of the progress he had made in the science was then entrusted with the PG & PW leading from the 2nd to the 3rd Degree. He then retired to be prepared for the ceremony.

The Lodge was then advanced to the 3rd Degree and Bro. Pyle was re-admitted and raised to the sublime degree of a " MM " the ceremony of raising being impressively rendered by W. Bro. G. Baskett

The W.M. then re-assumed the gavel and the Lodge was lowered to the 1st Degree. Bro. I.E. Hogben was then presented with his GL. certificate.

The following candidate was then proposed and seconded as a fit and proper person to become a Freemason:-
