

THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD  
LODGE MEETING HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, LONDON ROAD  
CAMBERLEY ON WEDNESDAY JANUARY 25th 1911.

The lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 4. 45 p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the brethren present.

W/Bro. G. Baskett assumed the gavel

The Lodge was then advanced to the 2nd degree when Bro. W. Vaughan S.W. and W/M elect was introduced to the installing Master for favour of installation.

The ancient charges were then read by the Secretary to the W.M. elect to all of which he signified assent.

The Lodge was then advanced to the 3rd. degree, after which all Brethren below the rank of an installed master retired and Bro. William Vaughan was then duly installed into the Chair of KS according to Ancient Custom. The installed Master having duly invested his " IPM " the Brethren were re-admitted and under the direction of the DC they saluted the WM in the 3 degrees.

The WM then invested his Officers for the ensuing year.

The following members were unanimously elected to serve on the Reference Committee for the ensuing year:- Bros. R. King, J. Way, F. Smallwood. A Charity Representative was then elected and on the proposition of W.Bro. W.J. Burn PM - seconded by W.Bro. J. Tew - W. Bro. A.M. Kennett was unanimously elected as CR. Bro. Kennett then thanked the Lodge for the honour conferred.

The W.M. then presented to W. Bro. R. Shepperd, IPM, on behalf of the Lodge, a Past Masters Jewel, paying him at the same time a high tribute on the efficient manner he had carried out his duties while W.M. of the Lodge. W. Bro. Shepperd then thanked the W.M. and the Brethren for their appreciation of his services.

The Lodge was then lowered to the 1st. Degree and greetings were given to the W.M. from the visiting Brethren.
