The death was reported of Bro Webb and the secretary was instructed to send a letter of condolence to his widow.

A Candidate for initiation was proposed and seconded.

Apologies for absence had been received from several brethren.

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or the Albert Edward Lodge in particular the Lodge was closed with solemn prayer at 7.45 pm.
