

This is an extract from the minutes of the Albert Edward Lodge meeting held at the Municipal Building, London Road, Camberley on Wednesday March 30th. 1910

Present were:- 11 Officers including W/M W/Bro. R. Shepherd
10 Members. No Guests

The Lodge was opened in due form after Solemn Prayer at 6.30 p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed

A ballot was then taken for Mr. Charles Edward Whisken
Mr. Herbert Theodore Hale
Mr. Francis Thomas Day

as candidates for Freemasonry - they having been duly proposed and seconded as fit and proper persons. At the conclusion of the ballot it was found unanimous in their favour.

Messrs Whisken and Hale were then introduced to the Lodge as the candidates properly prepared to be made Freemasons and were then duly initiated into the ancient mysteries and priviledges, the ceremony of initiation being ably rendered by the W/M (W/Bro. R Shepherd) who also gave the charge of this degree.

The Secretary then read a highly important letter from Grand Lodge in reference to unauthorized meetings.

Bros. F, Walker and J. Eighteen applied for their clearance certificates - granted

A letter from Bro. H. Watts applying for assistance from the B. Fund was then considered and the Secretary was instructed to write to this Bro. saying the Lodge could not accede to his request.

The Lodge then passed a unanimous vote of condolence to Bro. Parrant who had recently sustained a great loss by the death of his wife. The Secretary was instructed to write and convey the Lodges sympathy.

Several apologies from members for non attendance were received.

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or of this Lodge in particular it was closed in due form at 8 p.m.
