

THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD LODGE
MEETING HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, LONDON ROAD, CAMBERLEY
ON WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 30th 1912

3 Visitors

The lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 6.40 p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the brethren present

Bro. J. Meiklejohn was then called to the P. and after he had given proof of progress in the science was then entrusted with the P.G. and P.W. leading from the 1st to the 2nd degree, after which he retired to be prepared for the ceremony.

The lodge was then advanced to the second degree and Bro. Meiklejohn was re-admitted and passed to the degree of F.C, the ceremony of passing being ably rendered by the W/M (W.Bro. A. Gamble)

The explanation of the 2nd degree T. Board was then very impressively rendered by W. Bro. W. Vaughan I.P.M.

The lodge was then lowered to the 1st. degree

It was then resolved that the Reference Committee meet on November 13th 1912 for the purpose of Auditing Lodge accounts for the year

Letters of apology for non attendance by Bro.A.T. Lunn, W. Bro. Burn P.M. and other members, were read out by the secretary

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or this lodge in particular, it was then closed in perfect harmony at 7.50 p.m.
