

This is an extract from the minutes of the Albert Edward Lodge meeting held at the Cambridge Hotel on September 29th 1909.

Present were: 11 Officers inc The WM. W.Bro.Burn
10 Members and 2 Guests.

Bro.May was then passed to the degree of Fellowcraft. following which the WM *declared a cessation of Labour.*

Both ceremonies were carried in a very able manner by the W.Master.

One of the Brethren queried the suitability of the room being used and it was agreed that this be discussed at the next reference meeting.

Apologies for non-attendance had been received from several brethren.

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or the Albert Edward Lodge in particular the Lodge was closed with solemn prayer at 8.00 pm.
