

This is an extract from the minutes of the Albert Edward Lodge meeting held at the Municipal Building, London Road, Camberley on Wednesday September 27th 1911.

Present were: 10 Officers including W/M W/Bro. Vaughan  
10 Members  
1 Visitor

The Lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 6.30 p.m.  
The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the Brethren present.

Bro. F.M. Kenning was then called to the P and after he had given proof of progress in the Science was then entrusted with the PG & PW leading from the 1st to the 2nd degree, after which he retired to be prepared for that ceremony.  
The Lodge was then advanced to the 2nd degree and Bro Kenning was re-admitted & passed to the deg. of F.C. The ceremony of passing being ably rendered by the W.M. ( W. Bro. Vaughan )  
The explanation of the 2nd degree T.B. was then very impressively rendered by W. Bro. Jas Ellis P.M. Chap.  
The Lodge was now lowered to the 1st degree.  
The secretary then read a letter from the widow of our late W. Bro. Nicholson appealing to our Benevolent Fund for immediate assistance and on the proposition of W. Bro. G. Baskett seconded by W. Bro. R. Shepperd, that a sum of 5 guineas ( £ 290 in todays money ) be granted to this deserving case being put to the Lodge. The same was carried unanimously.
