

THIS IS AN EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE ALBERT EDWARD LODGE
MEETING HELD AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING LONDON ROAD CAMBERLEY ON
WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 25TH 1912

PRESENT WERE : 12 Officers (including W/M W/ Bro. Gamble)

MEMBERS : 15

VISITORS: 1

The lodge was opened in due form after solemn prayer at 6.40 p.m.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and confirmed by the Brethren present.

A ballot was next taken on behalf of Mr. John Meiklejohn who had been regularly proposed and seconded as a fit and proper person to be made a Freemason and at the conclusion of the ballot it was found to be unanimous in his favour.

Mr. John Meiklejohn was then introduced to the lodge as the candidate properly prepared to become a Mason and was then duly initiated into the Ancient Mysteries and Privileges of the order. The ceremony of initiation being ably rendered by the W.M (W/Bro A Gamble). The newly made brother then received the charge of the 1st degree, the same being given in an impressive manner by the S.W. (Bro. W.E. Matthews)

A letter was read from the Prov. Grand Secretary asking the lodge to adopt a " Form of Proposition of Candidate for Initiation " which the Prov. G. Master had drawn up for use in the Province.

W. Bro. A.M. Kennett proposed and W. Bro. G. Baskett D.C. seconded that the lodge adopt the proposal and such forms in future be used. The resolution was carried unanimously.

Letters of apology were received from several Brethren.

Nothing further being offered for the good of Freemasonry in general or this lodge in particular it was then closed in perfect harmony at 7.55 p.m.
